Before

 BBYC like many other clubs had no organised system for dealing with waste or caring for the environment in which will live and sail our boats.

Waste can be from:-

Operation of the club:-

- Restaurant... Food scraps or any waste directly into 1 bin
- Marina activities... Water taps left on, waste to 1 bin
- Administration... Paper waste and general to 1 bin

Implementation

- Worked with YNZ
- Formed a sustainability committee (4 members)
- Undertook an audit of the club activities
 - Areas included bar, restaurant, marina, administration
- Resulting from the audit a list of finding with corrective actions was created
- Club has set to work and completed many of the actions

Introduction

Bucklands Beach Yacht Club is located in Half Moon Bay, Auckland. The club offers its members a wide range of activities both on and off the water. These include: keelboat and centreboard racing, learn to sail programmes for all ages, haul out facilities, marina facilities, fishing events, power events, family cruising and a restaurant and bar where fellow boaties can have a drink/meal together. BBYC began it's environmental sustainability journey in 2021 with Helene Winter (board member). Helene began working with Green Gorilla to improve rubbish collection at the club and got BBYC involved with Litter Intelligence to begin regular beach clean ups and litter surveys of our local beach - Bucklands Beach. At the end of 2021 I (Brooke Switzer-Corbett) took over this role as Helene left the board. So far, I have run my own successful beach clean up and litter survey, formed a sub-committee for environmental sustainability at BBYC and registered the club with YNZ Clean Clubs. BBYC is rated as a three star clean club. The following progress towards the Clean Clubs actions is where BBYC is at currently and is a foundation for us to work on.
